Home Learning



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As the school has moved to remote learning, children will now be completing their work remotely from home. We understand that this is not easy but we are here to support you every step of the way.

We will be providing all children with 'Home Learning Pack' from school which you will be able to collect from school at an allocated time. More information will follow. Inside is an exercise book and pencil for children to use. A workbook to supplement online learning will also be supplied to each child.

The school website has a Home Learning section – it can be viewed at www.deyncourtprimary.org/home-learning/ and your child's class teacher will upload work daily. To access the work, you will be asked for a password - this is dog. If you have any questions or problems, please contact your child's teacher through Class Dojo or email the phase at:

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Morning introductions

The teachers will upload their weekly timetable to the Home Learning Portal on the website so you roughly know what the week will look like.

Teachers will start the 'school day' with an introduction via Microsoft Teams – this will be for about 15 minutes and this will be timetabled by year group.

All children have an email address and password that will enable them to join Microsoft Teams – this will have been sent via Class Dojo. The teacher will hold a meeting for their year group to attend so the learning for the day can be explained.

A document explaining the day will also be uploaded onto the Home Learning Portal if any children cannot attend the live session.

During the morning, your child will be invited to live sessions for Reading, English and Maths where they can get the input from their class teacher and then complete tasks independently. A Live Lesson timetable will be made available for all parents on Class Dojo.

Microsoft Teams



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You can access Teams via an internet browser via the following link - <https://teams.microsoft.com/>

For the most convenient & accessible solution we recommend downloading the app.

- If you have an Android or IOS smartphone/tablet, download the free app to your device from the relevant app store – just search for Microsoft Teams.
- On a PC or Mac you can download the desktop app from the following URL <https://www.microsoft.com/en-gb/microsoft-365/microsoft-teams/download-app>

After installing/opening the software you will need to enter an e-mail and password and these will have been sent to you via Class Dojo. Once you have entered these details, you will be able to login and see your child's 'Team.'

In the 'General' channel your teacher will post any general messages.

Please ask your child/children to login to Teams each morning – a timetable is available on Class Dojo to show different times for different year groups. If your child is unsure of the work for that day, they can ask a question in the discussion. Please explain to your child/children that the discussion board is not a chat facility and should not be used to talk with their friends. It is purely for work-based discussion and questions.

If you have any questions or queries regarding installing or accessing Microsoft Teams, please contact your child's teacher and we will try to help.

The 'School Day'



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During a closure, the class teacher will set work following the same pattern as in school with an English, Maths, reading/ RWI session then foundation subject in the afternoon.

Staff will provide links to website where they have lots of 'Live lessons' that will be incorporated into the curriculum. Children can watch these videos of the lessons and complete any activities in their books or on paper.

You can send your child's work via email or Class Dojo using the Portfolio function and the class teacher will respond to you.
