The Year 4 Multiplication Times Table Check, which is a new governmental assessment of Year 4 children relating to their times table knowledge (up to x12) will commence in the week beginning 6th June 2022.

The intention is for our pupils to complete this during the first week back after the Whitsun holiday. Mrs Bowater will conduct another practise with them beforehand and address any questions they may have.

If you need advice concerning methods to help your child, please contact your child's class teacher. Times Tables Rock Star is a very helpful tool to use and helps children gain confidence in their ability. If you need your child's password please speak to Mrs Bowater.
