Speaking, Listening and Writing	Write a fact file about 'The Stone Age'	Write a character description from a story you have read.	To research and write about a local historical/modern role model for Black History Month.	Learn a poem or create your own (Haiku, Kenning, Acrostic, etc).	Write about the process of how a loaf of bread is made- 'From field to table'
Problems, Science and Maths	Learn and write your number bonds to and within 20 (instant recall).	Create a fact file about 'an animal and what its diet is. Write as many facts as you can where the answer is your chosen number (eg $2 \times 3 = 36$)	Choose a times table to write out and learn it. (one of the following a week: 3s, 4s, 6s, 7s, 8s or 9s.)	With an adult, use a magnet around your home to record what materials are/aren't magnetic.
Art & Design	Create a detailed landscape picture of an environment of your choice. (artic, desert, rainforest, etc)	Paint a Self-portrait.	Design and draw a new cover for your favourite book.	Design a poster about how to stay safe online.	Make a picture using recycled materials from around your home
Constructing & Creating	Create a sculpture of an animal using unwanted materials from around your home.	Create your own shadow puppet.	Create, on paper, a new school uniform for D'Eyncourt.	With an adult, follow a recipe to make some food. Bring in a photo... or a portion for your teacher.	Create a healthy snack or meal and take a picture.
